



How to Copy Windows Easy Transfer program from Windows 7/8 to Windows 8.1/10

NOTE: Windows 8.1 and 10 does not include the Easy Transfer cable option in Windows Easy Transfer program.
The solution would be to copy the Windows Easy Transfer program version from Windows 7 or 8.

Steps	Using Windows 7 or 8 Machine
1	Boot PC to Windows 7 or 8.
2	<p>Click Start and enter “Windows Easy Transfer” in search bar. Or Click Start , click All Programs, click Accessories, click System Tools, click Windows Easy Transfer, and then click Next.</p> 
3	<p>Select This is my new PC.</p> 


Select "I need to install it now".



Choose where you want to copy the Windows Easy Transfer program. This example uses USB Flash Drive. (Plug in USB Flash Drive)




Wait until Windows Easy Transfer is copied into the USB Flash Drive or External hard disk. Close WET program.

Plug USB Flash Drive to Windows 8.1 or Windows 10 and run Windows Easy Transfer program.

Plug the Easy Transfer Cable to both computers. Run Windows Easy Transfer on the old computer again and start the connection process.
